Thank you for your interest in applying for the Jim Kane Scholarship Fund benefiting High School Senior participants or alum of First Tee – Coachella Valley. Thanks to the generosity of donors, we will be awarding up to \$30,000.00 (total) in scholarships to First Tee – Coachella Valley graduating high school seniors planning to attend college/vocational school or alum currently attending college/vocational school. The requirements and guidelines for scholarship applications are as follows:

Eligibility

- 1. Must have completed their junior year of high school or currently enrolled at a college/vocational school. Applicants must have a 2.5 or better GPA.
- 2. Must be enrolled or enroll at a college or university of his/her choice. Community colleges and vocational schools where associate degrees or Certification is earned *ARE* eligible.
- 3. Must have outstanding personal character, sportsmanship, and leadership qualities.
- 4. Must be a current member of FTCV, for no less than two years.

***Due to National College Athletic Association rules, Scholarship winners will not receive cash directly. Scholarship recipients are required to submit in writing the name and contact information of their college or university or trade school to FTCV within six (6) months of graduation. If funds are not dispersed within one (1) year of high school graduation, scholarship is deemed relinquished and dollars of said scholarship to be relinquished to the Jim Kane Scholarship Fund.
